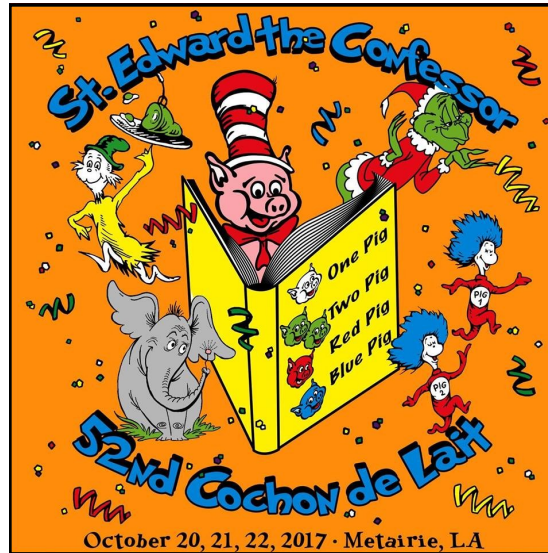

Wednesday and Thursday, October 18-19

Mega-Passes, valid for rides the whole weekend, will be sold at PRE-SALE for \$65 each. Mega-Passes will be sold during the fair for \$75 each until 4 p.m. on Sunday, October 22.

Pay-One-Price (POP) bracelets will be sold at PRE-SALE for \$20 and during the fair for \$25. The POP bracelet is valid for all rides on **EITHER** Saturday from 12 Noon until 5 p.m. **OR** on Sunday from 12 Noon until 4 p.m.

PRE-SALE tickets will be sold in Fun Packs of **20 tickets for \$18**. During the fair, tickets will be sold in Fun Packs of **20 tickets for \$20** and individual tickets will be sold for \$1.25 each.

Rides range from 1 to 3 tickets each. A list of rides will be posted at the pre-sale. Purchase your pre-sale tickets before the fair and save money!

Drive Thru to Pick Up Your Cochon Dinners!

The **Cochon Dinners** will be served under the Pavilion on **Sunday, October 22, beginning at 9 a.m.** There are no pre-sale tickets. The dinners will include roast pork, dirty rice, green beans, salad and bread. Drinks, beer, cracklin and desserts will also be available for purchase.

Drive thru pick up for Cochon Dinners will be available on **Sunday, October 22, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. only** in the back of the Parish Center.

To Drive Thru: travel west on Park Drive (toward Transcontinental), turn into the circle driveway in the back of the Parish Center; order; pay; receive your dinners; exit on Park Drive toward Transcontinental.
